SUBJECT : INVITATION TO THE 2023 PRIVATE EDUCATION NATIONAL CONFERENCE

DATE : November 22, 2023

1. The Department of Education, through the Private Education Office (PEO), will be launching the public-private education complementarity framework at the **2023 Private Education National Conference on December 12, 2023**, at the **Philippine International Convention Center, Pasay City**.
2. The said framework seeks to **promote coherence** in the development of the country's mixed education system, as the diverse contributions of various stakeholders are harnessed. Further, it **provides a basis** for developing a shared understanding of the goals of public-private partnership programs and strengthening consensus among stakeholders.
3. Thus, the PENC serves as a flagship platform for approximately 300 public and private education stakeholders to convene and be apprised of DepEd's efforts in strengthening private education, to collectively address the challenges and opportunities facing private education, and to engage them in the operationalization of the framework.
4. Given the foregoing, this Office **invites the selected participants (Annex A) to attend the PENC 2023**. Regional offices, division offices, and private school associations **that are yet to identify their representatives** shall submit their selected participant/s to their respective Regional Directors on or before

November 30, 2023, using the following template: bit.ly/47Av4ND. **Only those in the submissions consolidated at the regional level, reviewed, and signed by the Regional Director will be considered as the official participants.**

5. **Selected participants are requested to confirm their attendance on or before December 5, 2023, through this link: bit.ly/2023PENC.**
6. This is a **whole-day live-out activity**. Morning snacks, lunch, and afternoon snacks shall be provided, which shall be charged against PEO funds. Travel and transportation expenses, accommodation, and other incidental expenses of participants from the public sector shall be charged to their respective division/regional funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
