## **47TH NATIONAL DISABILITY RIGHTS WEEK**

- In reference to the Presidential Proclamation No. 597, s. 2024, declared the third week of July of every year as the "National Disability Rights Week", and Advisory No. 114, s. 2025, re: 47th National Disability Rights Week of the National Council on Disability Affairs, with the theme: "Innovation for Inclusion: Building Inclusive Communities Together", to be held on July 17-23, 2025. This year's NDR Week theme highlights the importance of innovation in promoting disability rights by developing inclusive tools, technologies, and policies. With this, SDO Lucena City through the Curriculum Implementation Division encourages all Special Education Schools to conduct and participate in activities related to the celebration.
