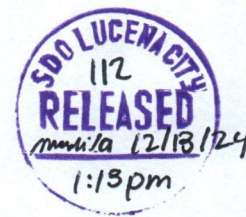

**ACCREDITATION AND EQUIVALENCY READINESS TEST**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Advisory titled “*Guidelines on the 2024 Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test Registration*”, the 2024 Accreditation and Equivalency Test shall be on January 26, 2025 (Sunday). Relative to this, the Schools Division Office of Lucena City through Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct the **ACCREDITATION AND EQUIVALENCY READINESS TEST** (Pre-Test) on the following schedule:

2. The objective of the activity is to assess the readiness of prospective test takers of the A & E Test; and measure performance of learners on the six learning strands of the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), at the Advanced Elementary and Junior High School levels.
3. Time of administration of test proper, LS1 to LS6 is 3 hours and 30 minutes for elementary level (189 items) and 6 hours and 30 minutes for JHS (378 items). Learners who will get average of 60% and above in the total score indicates mastery of the competencies. The result of the pre and post-test will be consolidated, analyzed and forwarded to the Regional Office. The post-test will be administered by the teachers in their respective CLC within the month of December 2024.
4. Attached are the Learners’ Scoring Sheet as Annex 1 and Item Analysis for Elementary Level as Annex 2.



5. Relative to the conduct of this activity which is scheduled on a Saturday, this Office reiterates that DepEd personnel who will attend and serve on weekends shall be entitled to a service credit as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 on *"Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers"* to compensate for the services they will render beyond working hours; likewise, Compensatory Time-off for Non-teaching Personnel based on CSM-DBM Joint Curricular No.2, s. 2004 re: *Non-Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Service Rendered*.
