GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

1. Skills Demonstration and Competition (SHS)

A. Specialization: Bread and Pastry – Cake Decorating

Guidelines and Mechanics:

- The competition is open to Senior High School learners under the Bread and Pastry Production specialization.
- Each participating school may send two (2) student representative for the competition.
- A pre-baked chiffon cake (single round layer) will be provided by the organizers as the base for decorating.
- Participants are required to bring their own decorating tools, ingredients, and materials, including icing, piping bags, turntables, nozzles, edible toppers, and other decorating items.
- The theme for cake decoration (e.g., *Celebration, Nature, Filipino Culture*) will be announced on the day of the competition.
- Participants must complete the decorating process within a 1-hour time limit.
- Proper sanitation, grooming, and safety practices must be observed throughout the demonstration. Participants must wear complete chef attire (chef's jacket, apron, hairnet, gloves).

Creativity and Theme Interpretation	30%
Neatness and Precision of Decoration	25%
Use of Techniques and Decorating Skills	20%
Overall Presentation and Visual Impact	15%
Sanitation and Safety Practices	10%

Reminders:

- Only the student competitor and one coach will be allowed in the designated preparation area.
- All decorations must be **edible** unless otherwise specified and approved by the organizers.
- Cakes will be placed on a display table after judging for **public viewing**.
- Any violation of food safety protocols may lead to disqualification.

B. Specialization: Electrical Installation and Maintenance (EIM) – Two-Way Lighting Control System

Guidelines and Mechanics:

- The competition is open to Senior High School learners under the Electrical Installation and Maintenance (EIM) specialization.
- Each participating school may send two (2) student representatives for the competition.
- Each participant will install a two-way lighting control system based on a provided wiring diagram.
- A demo board (plywood 2ft x 2ft) and basic electrical materials such as a lamp holder, bulb, and 2-way switches must be prepared by the participants.

- Participants must bring their own tools, wires, mounting materials, electrical tape, and personal protective equipment (PPE).
- The wiring diagram and task instructions will be announced on the day of the competition.
- Participants must complete the wiring task within a 1-hour time limit.
- Proper electrical safety, work organization, and tool handling must be observed at all times. Participants must wear complete PPE (long pants, uniform or apron, closed shoes, gloves, etc.).

Reminders:

- Only the student competitor and one coach will be allowed in the designated preparation area.
- The lighting system must function properly—the lamp must be operable from both switches.
- Participants must label all components and ensure wires are properly terminated.
- All materials and tools must be organized and safely used throughout the task.
- Unsafe practices or incorrect wiring may result in point deductions or disqualification.
- All completed boards will be displayed after judging for public viewing.

2. Product Selling Booths

Products: Bread & Pastry and Cookery Items

Guidelines:

- Open to both JHS and SHS learners under Bread & Pastry and Cookery.
- Each school may set up one booth only, which must be decorated and labeled appropriately.
- Products must be prepared and packaged safely, with price tags visible.
- Learners must be hands-on in selling and customer interaction.
- Booths must be ready for inspection 30 minutes before the official opening (8:30 AM).

Criteria for Judging (Optional for Booth Awards):

- Product Quality and Taste – 30%
- Creativity and Presentation – 25%
- Customer Service and Salesmanship – 25%
- Booth Design and Cleanliness – 20%
- Total – 100%

3. Tech-Voc Quiz Bee

Platform: Quizizz

Participants: 5 learners per group, Grades 7–12 mixed

Guidelines:

- Each school may form one team of 5 learners, composed of any combination from Grade 7 to 12.
- The quiz will be conducted online using Quizizz Live platform (projected for audience view).
- Questions will be in multiple-choice format and will cover the following areas:
 - ICT (e.g., basic digital tools, software)
 - AFA (e.g., basic Agri-fishery practices)
 - HE (e.g., break and pastry, cookery)
 - IA (e.g., EIM, SMAW)

Mechanics:

- The competition will consist of three rounds:
 - Easy – 1 point per correct answer
 - Average – 2 points per correct answer
 - Difficult – 3 points per correct answer
 - Each question will appear on the screen with a time limit per item based on difficulty.
 - Participants must use their own mobile device or a school-provided gadget with internet access; backup devices should be ready if possible.
 - In case of a tie, tiebreaker question(s) will be administered immediately using the same platform.
 - Top three teams with the highest scores will be declared winners.
 - Teachers shall supervise participants to ensure academic honesty.
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4. Infomercial Contest

Theme: Promotion of TLE/TVL Specializations (ICT; AFA, HE, IA)

Guidelines:

- Open to one (1) group from Junior High School and one (1) group from Senior High School per school, with a maximum of five (5) members per group.
- The infomercial must:
 - Focus on promoting any one TLE/TVL specialization
 - Be 1 to 2 minutes in length
 - Be submitted in MP4 format, with appropriate title and credits
- Entries must use original content (no copyright violations).
- Schools must pre-screen and endorse their entries before submission to the division.

Criteria for Judging:

- Relevance to Theme / Informational Value – 30%
- Creativity and Visual Impact – 25%
- Originality and Content Quality – 25%
- Technical Quality (audio/video clarity, editing) – 20%
- Total – 100%
